## Nomination Form for Small Employer Class

This award recognizes leadership through best practices in prevention and timely return to work.

### Eligibility

1. All employers holding an account in good standing with WorkSafeBC in subsector 7110 are eligible for the Safety Leadership Award.
2. The organization must not have any outstanding compliance order(s) with WorkSafeBC greater than 30 days old at the time of nomination.
3. The organization must not have a workplace fatality within the past three years.
4. The organization is not presently being prosecuted for a violation under the Workers Compensation Act of BC or the Criminal Code of Canada.

### Criteria

1. Submission of the company's workplace health and safety program.
2. What method was used to identify the need for specific program elements? Did this identification process include a method to solicit employee feedback, workplace inspection, the tracking of safety data and acting on the data, or a process to identify hazards and develop and implement hazard controls.
3. What extent were the specific program elements developed with workplace stakeholders?
4. What consideration was given to risk control measures? Did the consideration include elimination, substitution, process change, engineering controls, administrative controls such as safe work procedures, or personal protective equipment?

5. How is health and safety a consideration in the business plan and the sustainability of the business?

6. What is the potential for implemented health and safety initiatives across the food and beverage industry?
